Tarmac reports – 4 staff members suspended which will result in disciplinary action. It is likely that highways will be short staffed in the near future. Our reports led to the discovery of many more misdemeanors. Matters will be resolved in January.
Ysgol Pennant – Cylch met with PCC officers. They have a new idea to spend the grant funding on a new caban for Cylch only (rather than also building an extension onto school) this prejudices the outcome of the proposed closure of Ysgol Pennant . YAYP (Ymdrech Achub Ysgol Pennant) met with MP and MS – they will make enquiries on YAYP's behalf. Ysgol Bodfor, Anglesey was in a similar position, YAYP will make contact with representatives from that school.
Schools Transformation Programme – Last Tuesday, cabinet decided to change Llanfair primary and High school to an all through Welsh-medium school to serve whole of Montgomeryshire.

Highways (14)

1. Main road opposite carpark by Llys Cynog is blocked
2. Potholes along Cwm Rhiwarth Road.
3. Some of the Pennant Melangell road, which runs parallel to Llechweddygarth drive - the tarmac where Highways resurfaced does not join the verge. There is quite a drop from the road down to the verge in some areas, with some of the tarmac breaking away. It's an accident waiting to happen.
4. The road from Bryn Celyn down to the village is deteriorating with potholes getting worse
5. There are also potholes on the road up towards Trefechan where the road wasn't resurfaced

- 6. Culverts up to Rhydyfelin have not been cleared yet plus an area of road that is breaking away
 - 7. Potholes are also forming on the road to Rhydyfelin
 - 8. The triangular piece of road up by Rhydyfelin is still in a terrible state
 - 9. Culverts up RHIWARTH valley are all blocked.
 - 10. Culverts along main road to Penybontfawr also blocked
 - 11. Road past Berwynfa – does it belong to Council? Needs tarmac
